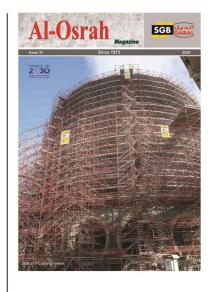

In 2020 we have a couple of major projects which will keep our business development team busy for a while.

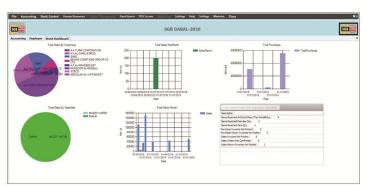

Factory Update

Al-Dabal Scaffolding Factory

SGB Al-Dabal factory in the 2nd Industrial area has recently added a new fiber laser cutting machine into its production line. This automated laser cutting machine is becoming a key factor of success of the manufacturing in our business sector. Previously, we had to outsource some of our products specially the hooks for the newly introduced steel scaffold boards which were not only costing heavily due to the rising labor cost but was increasing the delivery time also. The new laser cutting machine allows quick and precise cutting with extremely high repetition accuracy, more efficiency and less wasted time and raw materials.

Recently, SGB Al-Dabal secured a sale order through its office in Jubail to supply Cuplok system scaffolding along with the steel boards to NAS Trust Corp. They will use the cuplok system for the internal and external access scaffolds in SABIC for maintenance and shutdowns. Prior to placing the order NAS representatives visited our factory and showed a complete satisfaction.

SGB Al-Dabal has also been awarded a huge project to supply and erect scaffolding around the cooling tower of SAFCO in Jubail. This project required hundreds of tons of system scaffold, tube and fittings and the steel boards. Due to the height, width and nature of the project our team in the factory needed to make sure that all the components are made properly and checked thoroughly before they are delivered to the project. It was really a big challenge but our workforce in the factory worked long hours keeping production speed and maintaining quality at a remarkable speed. The required material was delivered on time, a job very well done by our workforce at the factory.

SAFCO IV Cooling Tower – SPECIAL PROJECT

SGB Al Dabal have this year taken on the mammoth task of scaffolding the external shell of the SAFCO IV Concrete Cooling Tower. Andy Morrison – SGB Al Dabal Contracts General Manager said "This is the biggest single scaffold ever built in SABIC and is undoubtedly a once in a lifetime project.

"SAFCO approached SGB Dabal in early 2018 and explained the problem that the Cooling Tower, has resembled the shape of your typical "lamp shade", had serious delamination (crumbling) of concrete and steel reinforcing bars inside the concrete. This was caused by Sea Salt Air attacking the re-bar by slowly permeating the concrete and eventually corroding the re-bar, which then caused the concrete to disintegrate. There were large pieces of concrete literally falling off the Cooling Tower every day and was an obvious danger to personnel who worked or walked nearby. SAFCO had already placed a protective screen around the base to eliminate the potential of injury from the falling concrete.

The main issue when scaffolding, was not only the height of 52m, or the total circumference of 232m, but also the Cooling Tower shape being circular and from the bottom to the top of the Cooling Tower there was a cantilever of over 10m. The bottom had base dimension 72m diameter and the top 52m diameter, thus the Cooling Tower has a sloping external face of solid concrete. There were also 24 massive 8.4m high cooling fans at the base, which had to be bridged over and must continue to operate while the scaffolding was being built. (The CT provides the cool water to keep the plant from overheating, especially during the warmer summer months.)

Although SGB Dabal carries out a full CAD design service, part of the scaffolding standard is to engage with a Third Party on special projects. We decided to engage with world renowned scaffolding design company Scaftec Ltd. who are based in Glasgow, Scotland and have produced scaffold designs all over the world such as Perth in Australia and Jamaica in the Caribbean. The Scaftec team led by Mr. Bill Ferguson MD and Mr. Gary Ferguson M Eng.(Director) and Mr. Mihal Pawlek BEng Hon. MSc, specialist in the use of finite element analysis design software and calculations

SABIC ATC were lead engineers on this project. They were professionally led by Dr. Mahmoud M. Hassan, Professor of Eng., Dr. Alper and SAFCO Mr. Faisal M Hadher – Manager Major Maintenance, who all visited Scaftec in Glasgow accompanied by SGB Al-Dabal team to discuss possible design solutions and all critical components of this design. SAFCO in-house engineer department AED were heavily involved with Mr. Abdulrahman A. Abdulbasith – Civil Engineer giving expert advice on the history and background of the problems with the cooling Tower and the basic plan to fix the crumbling concrete.

On a structure of this complexity, it is imperative that Computer Modelling is carried out, which looks at all member (tubes) on the scaffold design and runs an irrative process and takes into account loadings for wind, live load (men working on the scaffold), leg loadings, stresses and loadings on all scaffolding members (Tubes), lateral and vertical deflections, stability checks for sliding and overturning in compliance with SES B01-E01. Load combinations, dynamic analysis including natural frequency and designs for anchor bolts and the loadings imposed on all approximately 3,000 anchors/bolts. SCIA modelling set about producing some preliminary designs with the criteria that

the scaffold was not to be tied (Bolted/Anchored) to the Cooling Tower. Thus they worked on Modelling a Butted Scaffold design taking into account wind speeds, load combinations, dynamic analysis including natural frequency and many more parameters and Codes of Practice. This ultimately could not be proven. Even going back, a second time, with more special software to again try and find a solution.



Initially the scaffold was only going to be 4 lifts of boards, which wo

uld be stripped and moved as work progressed, but after SAFCO ATC deciding to go for a static design which would Anchor/Bolt the scaffold to the CT the main requirements for the scaffold dramatically increased with SAFCO going all out and asked for 22 lifts of boards, 4 No. Loading Towers, and 6 no. stair case access towers to 52m high and 3,000 no. anchors bolts and special fittings to secure the scaffold to the Cooling Tower.

These loadings are then given to SABIC ATC who then enter them in their Computer Model of the Cooling Tower to ascertain whether the Cooling Tower concrete structure can support the imposed loadings from the scaffolding.

SAFCO IV Cooling Tower - SPECIAL PROJECT - (continuation)

The SABIC Standard for scaffold dictated that the wind speed of 210 km per hour be used for the Jubail area and "...gusts at 10m above the ground for the plant site exposure category "C" and associated with 1,700 years return period...." This is an extremely high standard, but standards are there to be followed. After many months of trying to get answers for the of questions and clarifications the design of a static (bolted) scaffold structure was finally approved by SABIC ATC and SAFCO AED.

There was a 3-month procurement period with a team lead by SGB Al-Dabal's President – Mr. Emad K. Al Dabal and our Factory Manager Mr. Nadeem Sheik and purchasing department spending many long days talking to international suppliers to source materials and manufacture special beams from UK, staircases from Dubai and anchor bolts from Germany, however the majority of the material over 80% was manufactured in Kingdom with all the galvanized Steel boards, Cuplok System Scaffold, scaffold tube and the special Steel Back Anchors Plates manufactured in SGB Al-Dabal's factory at Dammam 2nd Industrial city.

SGB Al-Dabal started building the scaffold on 11th of June 2019 with a build time of just over 6 months. The daily building was over seen by SGB Al-Dabal's - Mr. Lyndon Johnson-Project Manager and SAFCO's - Mr. Musaed Serdah Al Khaldi Engineer Major Maintenance, who commented "SGB Al-Dabal's excellent pre planning and staged delivery of materials in an orderly manner, along with experienced scaffolders, safety officers and project management team, created a mutual understanding between contractor and client and resulted in the scaffold being built safely, on time and within budget.

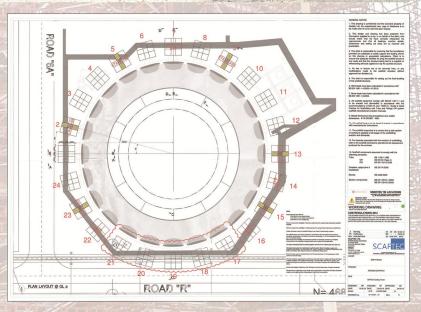
Regular site visits from Scaftec MD Mr Bill Ferguson were crucial at the most important phase - The Setting Out - making sure that we started at the correct points so that when we reached the top all scaffold standards did not overlap. Further visits highlighted some scaffold changes that were required due to existing staircases that could not be moved, 1-ton fan motors that had to be replaced, required additional support structures to winch new motors into position and electrical cable lines that we had to build around-Scaftec came up with solutions for all. It showed genuine commitment that the MD under took these visits Special mention must go to our clients SAFCO maintenance team of Mr. Muhammad Saud F. Al Shammari - Sr. Manager T/A & Major Maintenance, who always kept a cool head and provided encouragement during the long design phase and laterally Mr Abdulrahman S. Qasim -Engineer, who took over as the build progressed and gave tremendous support and resolved any issues effective and with a fair hand. Mr. Raja Thangaraj - SAFCO Planning Engineer was our daily contact and worked tirelessly to ensure that any obstacles were overcome with enthusiasm and a smile. (after the shouting had died down).

There was genuine commitment from all parties, with excellent cooperation between the Designers Scaftec, ATC/AED, SAFCO and SGB Al-Dabal site teams working together to overcome any problems in a cooperative manner. The scaffolding build was completed on the 15th of January 2020 and the repairs are expected to take the best part of 12 months to completed.

We wish SAFCO and their contractors a safe project.

- Abqaiq Main Plant incident in emergency within 24 hrs. we have mobilized more than 50 scaffolders & additional materials.
- * Khurais Plant incident in emergency within 24 hrs. we have mobilized more than 35 scaffolders & additional materials.

Contracts Highlights

SABIC (Saudi Basic Industries)

2019 has been an extremely busy year for Turnarounds in SABIC Plants.

The year kicked off with a full program of Turnarounds in SADAF with Styrene I with 25 ton exchangers were being replaced in March and with SAFCO Ammonia plant in May, where SGB Dabal carried out all the difficult pipe repair and replacement scaffolds. This was followed by Ar Razi I in June and then Ar Razi IV in August, SADAF EDC in August was the biggest SABIC turnaround in 2019 and involved over 4,000 scaffolds built during difficult summer conditions, which was then dismantled and the scaffolds rebuilt for SADAF MTBE with the major internals scaffold on the 54m high Reactor & Regenerator have all be completed safely and were finished by the end of December 2019.

SGB Dabal have provided all the scaffolding services during November 2019 Ibn Zahr MTBE I turnaround with over 2,500 scaffolds. They have a full schedule into April 2020 with turnarounds on PP1 and then PP2, followed by MTBE II. They also have a major project in PP Plant to refurbish the Steel frame for the 46m Silos and SGB Dabal must ensure that we bridge over the roads to allow the tractor trailers to pass through the scaffold and have uninterrupted traffic flows to deliver the products to clients.

It is also worth mentioning that our Senior Supervisor in Ibn Zahr Mr. Mohammed Khushal completed all the pre-turnaround scaffolds, but unfortuanetly had a heart attack one night back at camp. He had emergency surgery and has made an excellent recovery and is leaving to convalescence with his family for 3 months. SGB Dabal and Mr Khushal would like to thank the many Ibn Zahr personnel of all levels, who took the time to visit him in hospital and at the camp during his recovery. This showed a genuine concern for a long serving contractor employee and has earned everyone's respect and further enhanced our long term business friendship. We all wish him a full recovery and hope he will be back in Ibn Zahr sites in the near future - Inshallah.

In Jubail in 2019, SASREF had its biggest ever turnaround, with the full plant going down for over 3 months. All units OPD I, OPD II, OPC and Utilities as well a major pipe & pipe rack replacements and a new unit were installed. There were over 5,000 men used during the turnaround and with "tie-ins" to the new plant and units being completed during this phase as well as replacement of the Coils(Tubes) in mega Furnace F6001.SGB Dabal carried out scaffolding services on OPD 1 & OPD II and completed them safely and ahead of schedule.

There seems to be a reduced plan next year for Turnarounds with SADAF (now called Petrokemya North), who usually have 3 per year have none planned, but this is in preparations for a once every 10 years' full plant turnaround in 2021 which will cover EDC, Styrene I & II and Utilities. We fully expect that, as always, there will be unplanned and unexpected calls for our services, which all goes well for our 2020 work load plan.
